On November 26, 2019, the Board of Supervisors of Alameda County adopted Ordinance No. 2019-59, implementing the 2019 California Building Standards Code. This includes the Construction and Demolition Debris Management Program (Chapter 15.08.190, Section 470) for the unincorporated areas of Alameda County.
