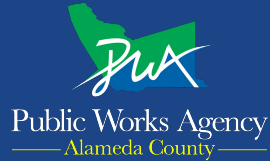

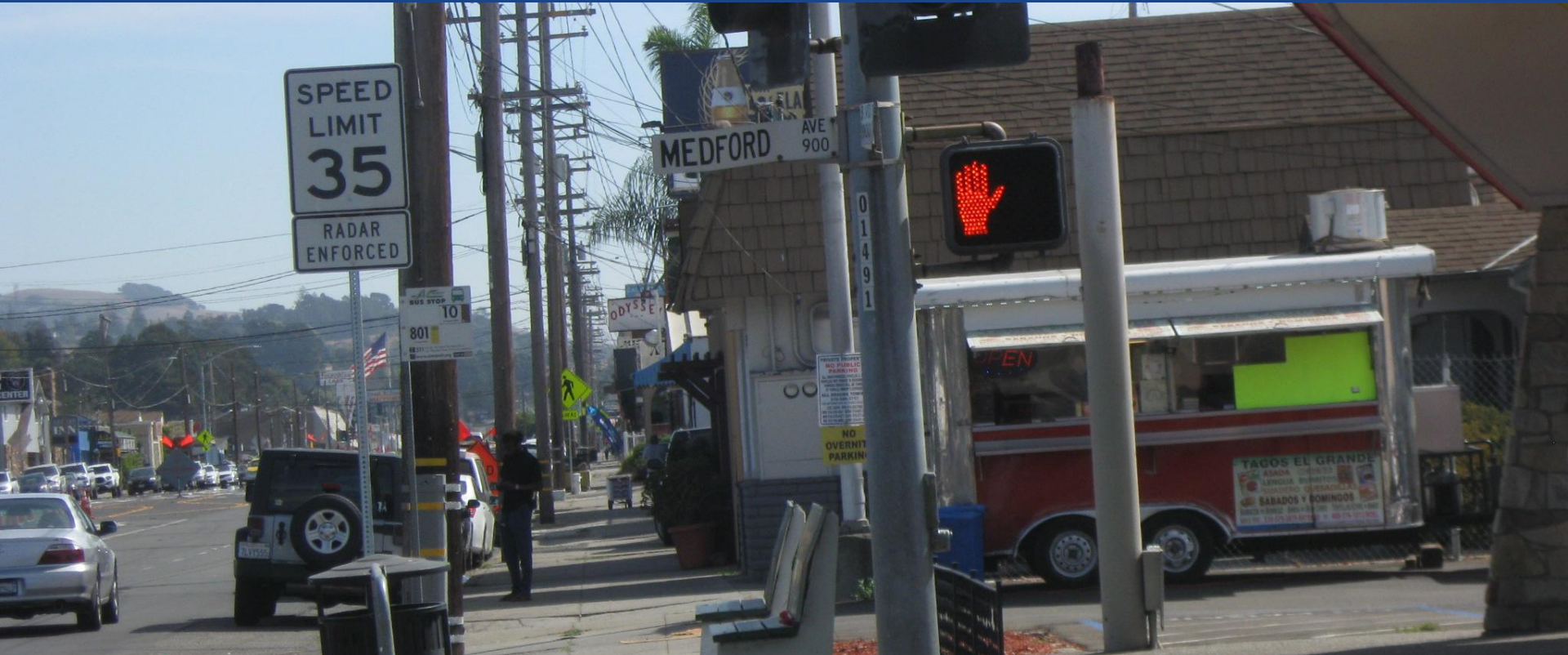

Mission Blvd at Grove Way

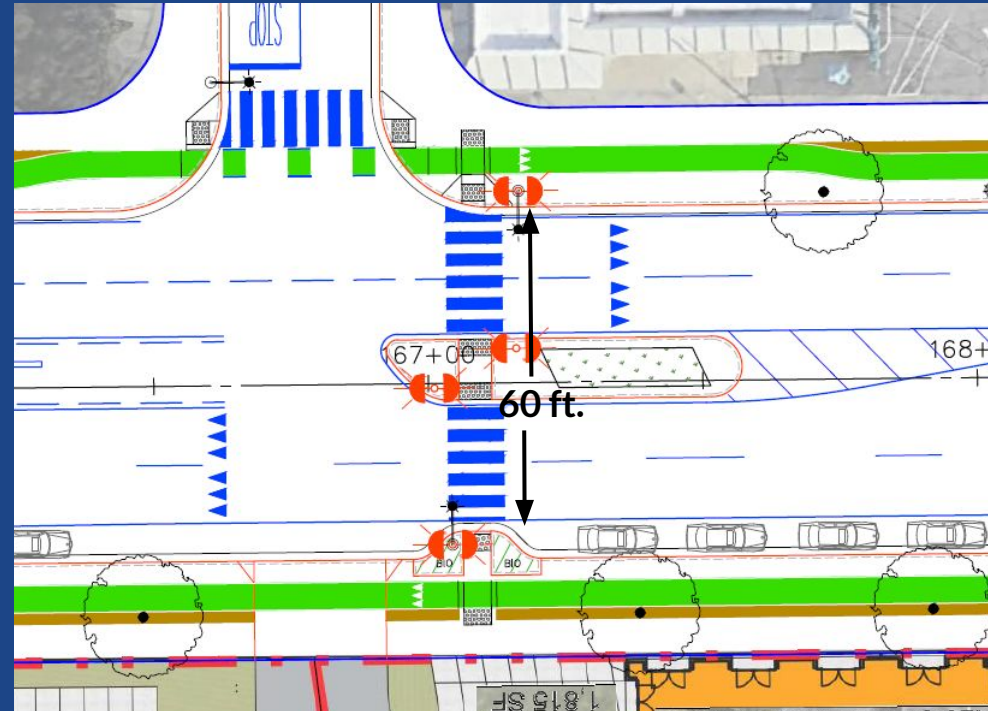


High Visibility Crosswalk

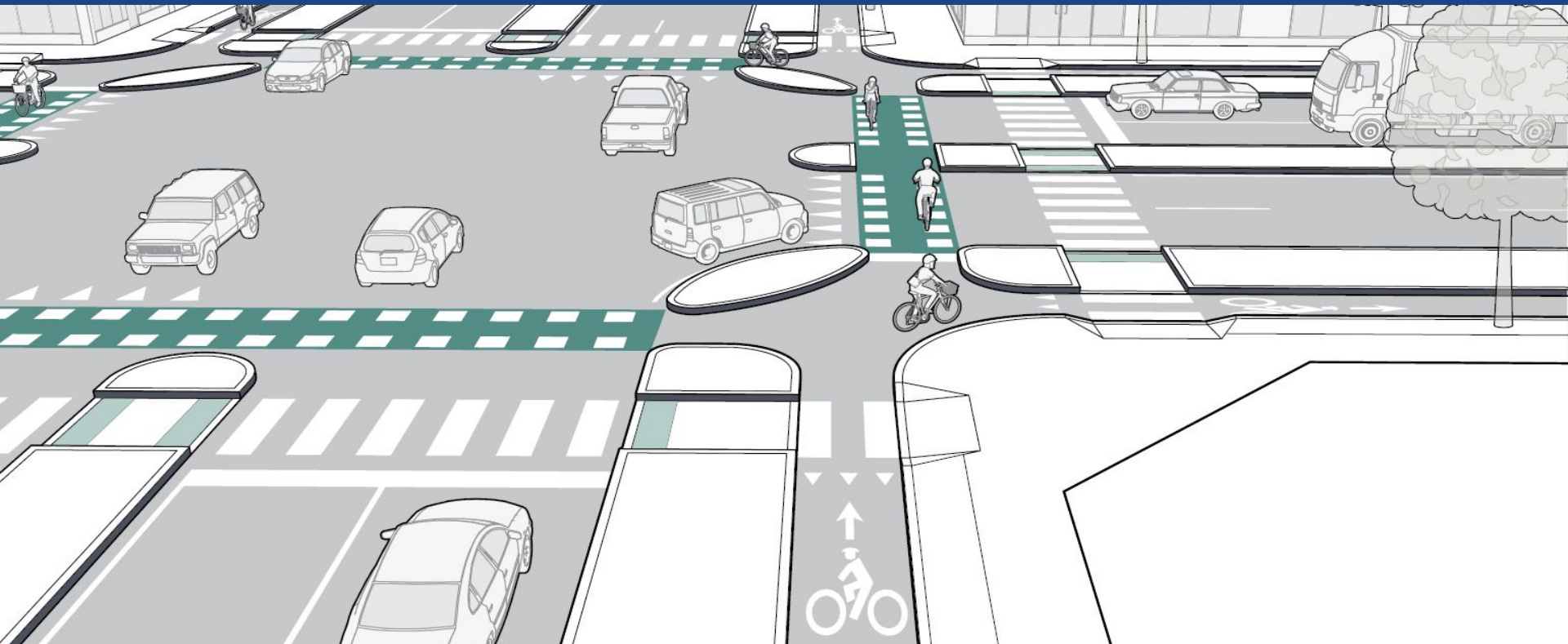


Existing Bike Lanes - None

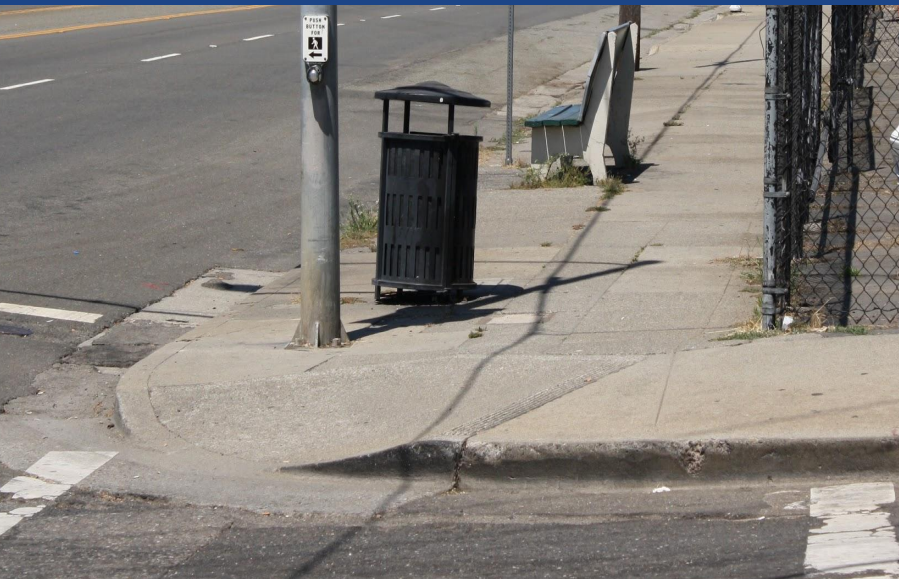


Proposed Bike Lanes - Separated

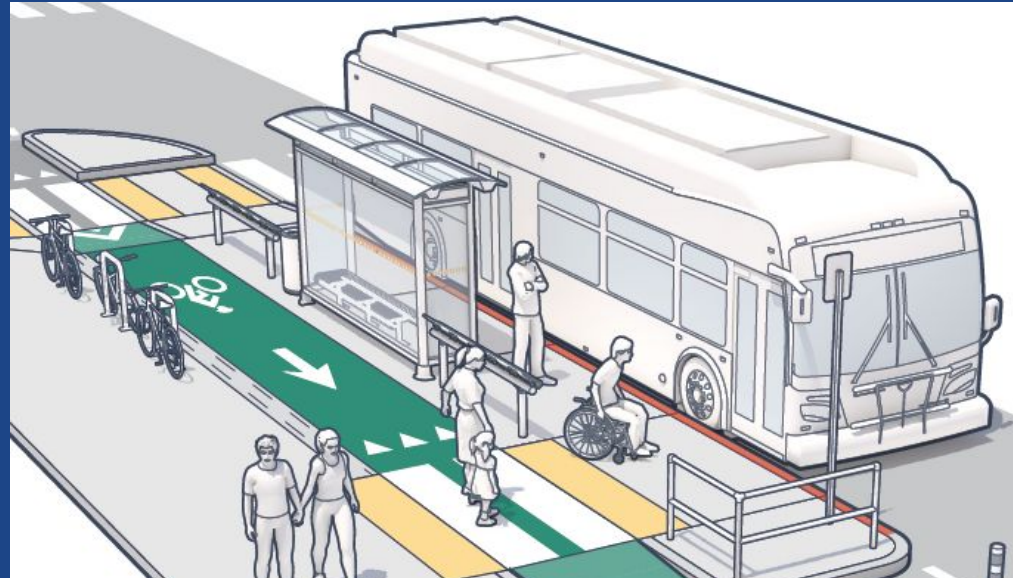
