THE INSTALLATION OF A FULL TRASH CAPTURE DEVICE ON VIA ARRIBA BETWEEN VIA MANZANAS AND VIA MIRABEL

SAN LORENZO, ALAMEDA COUNTY – Please be advised that Alameda County Public Works Agency will be installing an underground full trash capture device in-line with the existing storm drain system on Via Arriba near Via Manzanias. Construction is anticipated to begin on May 5, 2025, and the project is scheduled to be completed by end of October, 2025.

Due to site space constraints, limited construction equipment staging and access, and the extent of excavation and shoring required, Via Arriba between Via Mirabel and Quigley Road will be closed to through traffic for the duration of the project, to ensure public safety. Local traffic to and from homes and apartments on Via Arriba south of Via Mirabel will be maintained at all times. East end of Via Manzanias at Via Arriba will also be closed during construction period.

Construction hours are Mondays through Fridays from 8:00AM to 5:00PM. No work will be performed on weekends or holidays. Portion of curb parking on Via Arriba within the project construction and staging areas will not be available during the construction period. Access to driveways will be maintained.

While the County continually strives to minimize construction impacts to adjacent neighborhoods, we also recognize the likelihood of increased noise levels during construction operations due to the need for specialized heavy construction machinery and equipment. The construction operations will comply with Cal-OSHA requirements and local noise ordinances.
