

General Project Description



- Demolition, site preparation, excavation and grading
- Construction of new concrete curbs, gutters, driveways, curb ramps
- Construct/install storm drain improvements, traffic signal improvements, fiber optic conduit
- Adjustment of various utility facilities to grade and perform reconnections for private properties (e.g., meter boxes, manhole covers, etc.)
- Install trees, plants, etc. and maintain plants during plant establishment period
- Mill and overlay
- Restripe and relocation/installation of roadside signs



California Air Resources Board (CARB) In-Use Off-Road Diesel-Fueled Fleets Regulation Compliance










Construction Compliance (Jami)



Labor Code Requirements

- Prevailing wage is applicable to all PWA projects
- Elation Systems is the web-based system that contractors and subcontractors are required to use on a weekly basis for the submission of certified payroll.

Contract Compliance

- Elation Systems is also utilized to monitor subcontractor utilization.
 Contractors are required to upload all payments made to their subs.
- DIR: All bidders (prime and subcontractors) who bid on a public works project must be registered with the Department of Industrial Relations by the date of bid opening. \$300 ANNUAL FEE.
- Alameda County Public Works Agency strongly encourages the participation of disadvantaged/minority/women-owned business enterprises in all District capital improvement construction projects.

Contractor Technical Assistance Program (CTAP)

- Assists small and local contractors
- Identifies and Shares Alameda County's construction contracting opportunities
- Provides technical assistance including certification assistance, one-on-one training, workshops, and seminars
- Offers bonding assistance for qualifying projects up to 40% of the bond amount or \$750,000, whichever is less
- CTAP is sponsored by the General Services Agency (GSA) and administered by Merriwether & Williams Insurance Services
- To be eligible for CTAP contractors must be Alameda County SLEB Certified
