2	The guardrail system's are generally installed by a specialty subcontractor but it's a large portion of this project. Can those items be designated as specialty items so as to not count towards the 40% minimum GC goal? Doing so would allow more flexibility in subcontracting out other items that we would normally do ourselves to DBE contractors.	No

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3	Can the 15G Form and the Good Faith Effort be submitted by 4pm on the 4 th day following the bid as is typical?	No
4	SP-259 states to clear and grub the entire length of the jobsite unless otherwise shown or directed. Can you give any more direction as to the extent of what you want done? There is no new mulch or other dressing shown to be installed so are you looking to just spray and mow any weeds or something more than that?	Remove any objectionable material that is in conflict with your construction of the project.
5	SP-261 states to cut tree branches to 14.5' over the roadway and thin the trees. Can this material be chipped and spread on site?	Yes
6	When are you anticipating start of construction on this project? Given that the project duration is so short and there is potential lead time on some of the materials such as light poles, will the NTP be delayed until materials are available?	Start of construction/issuance of the NTP will consider lead times for the acquisition of certain materials
7	Item#18, MGS – 7ft. Wood Post: The 7ft. wood post shown on CDOT 2018 RSP A77N1 is 8"x 8" x 7'-0". Is this the dimensioning of the wood posts the engineer wants for MGS line posts?	See Addendum No. 1.
8	Item #19, Long Span Nested MGS-7ft. Wood Posts: Appendix K, Figure 12A shows 6"x 8"x 6'-0" CRT posts and a single W-Beam rail element. Why does Bid Item #19 say nested and 7ft. Wood Post?	See Addendum No. 1.
