

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

On *February 15, 2022*, the Board of Supervisors of Alameda County approved this invitation for bids to provide all labor, material, equipment, mechanical workmanship, transportation, and services required for work to be performed on:

**THE NEW SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION ON
REDWOOD ROAD
AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS
In EDEN TOWNSHIP, ALAMEDA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA**

GENERAL WORK DESCRIPTION: The project consists of providing and implementing a traffic control plan; providing construction area signs; providing and implementing water pollution control plan; providing construction site management; sweeping streets; notifying and coordinating with utility companies, schools, businesses, and property owners; clearing and grubbing; performing minor roadway excavation and site grading; construction survey staking; removing and disposing existing concrete, asphalt concrete, and gravel pathways and driveways; constructing concrete curb, gutter, sidewalk, driveway, pedestrian ramps; removing tree(s); converting street light pole; relocating traffic signing and striping; furnishing and applying water; cleaning site; and constructing other related work necessary to complete said project.

ALLOTTED TIME FOR COMPLETION: 45 working days.

LICENSE REQUIREMENT: The Contractor must have a Class A or C-8 license at the time of bid opening. Licensing must be maintained throughout the Contract duration.

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENT: To be qualified to bid or to be listed in a bid proposal, all contractors must be registered with the Department of Industrial Relations.

BIDS DUE: Tuesday, March 29, 2022, 2:00 p.m., at the Public Works Agency, 951 Turner Ct, Rm 300, Hayward, CA 94545. Bids submitted after this deadline will be rejected. Submissions accepted prior will be publicly open and read immediately following the deadline. Include a bidder's security equal to at least 10 percent of the bid. All prime contractors and interested subcontractors are invited and encouraged to attend. **Attendance of Pre-Bid meeting is one of the requirements to fulfill Good Faith Effort for meeting M/WBE requirements.**

COVID-19: The Public Works Agency will be following the County Health Officer's latest Shelter In Place Order or other applicable orders and guidance concerning social distancing, if any, in place during the bid process. Bid Opening may be limited to one attendee per company, and may take place in several rooms with Agency personnel teleconferencing from a separate room.

SUBCONTRACTING GOALS: 15% to Minority Owned Businesses and 5% to Women Owned Businesses. Submit the M/WBE Commitment, Information, and Good Faith Effort Checklist forms with the Bid. Submit good faith documentation no later than 2:00 p.m. on the second business day following bid opening.

Alameda County strongly encourages the participation of disadvantaged/minority/women owned businesses in public works projects and the hiring of apprentices who reside within the County. WAGES: The Contractor and all subcontractors must pay not less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages to all workers. Copies of the required prevailing rates are on file at the Agency location where bids are due.
