1	A question was asked during the Pre-bid meeting that was held on April 18, 2023, whether a traffic control plan is required of the Contractor to submit even though a traffic control plan is included in the project plans.	Yes, the Contractor is still required to submit a wet stamped (by a licensed Traffic or Civil Engineer) traffic control plan.
2	Bid item 8. Will the County allow the contractor the use of their K-Rail onsite for this project and supplement it as needed for safety?	No. Bid Item #8 calls for the Contractor to supply 420' long temporary railing (Type K). The Contractor will have to contact the County to remove existing K-rail prior to the start of construction.
3	The quantities for bid items 20 and 21 seem reversed per the plan set call outs. Please clarify.	The quantities for bid items 20 and 21 are correct. Bid Item 20: HMA Type A refers to the material for HMA Dike. Bid Item 21: HMA-LV refers to the HMA 3" paving patch along the roadway and 6" paving patch around the inlets.
4	Are portable changeable message signs (PCMS) required for this project? If so please add an item for this work.	No portable changeable message signs are required for this project

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5	Is there any soils or geotechnical report available for this project. Are there any data cores for our review.	No reports or data cores available.
6	Is epoxy coated rebar required for this project?	No.
7	Please clarify whether to use metal construction signs or rag construction signs.	See Section 12-3.01B in the project specifications.
8	Although the bid item list does not indicate Final Pay Items, are there any items that are final pay for this project?	No.
