9E	Since the plans do not provide enough information for me to perform my own earthwork, I need to know if bid item 14 "Roadway Excavation Pavement" 2150 cy includes the cut and fill quantity? If so, how much cut and how much fill? Are we to off haul and dispose of 2150 cy of dirt?	For bidding purposes, assume a Roadway Excavation Pavement Disposal amount of 2150 CY (see Addendum 1).
10E	Same concern as above plans do not provide enough information for me to perform my own earthwork, I need to know if bid item 15 "Roadway Excavation Sidewalk" 900 cy includes the cut and fill quantity? If so, how much cut and how much fill? Are we to off haul and dispose of 900 cy of dirt?	For bidding purposes, assume a Roadway Excavation Sidewalk Disposal amount of 900 CY (see Addendum 1).
11E	We have a bid for adjust fence/gate of 100 LF. Are we to include also 100 LF of fence demolition under this bid item? Keynote 2 on demolition plan sheets calls to remove fence. I don't see a Keynote that shows location of which fences to adjust?	No, demolition is not included under this bid item. Fence removal is included under the Clearing and Grubbing bid item. For adjustment of fences, please see Keynote 1 under the demolition plan.
12E	Can you please provide further information on the Contractor's scope of work for bid item 60 "Relocate Service Box AT&T".  This cabinet is located at the intersection of Blossom/Haviland.	Relocation will be done by utility owner. Cabinet to be setback adjacent to existing fence. See Addendum 1
