Please provide details of how the guardrail posts are attached to the CDIH piles?</p> <p>The (plan) guardrail profiles show the posts are not aligned and are offset with the CDIH piles.</p>	<p>The (pre-bid meeting) citing of "some guardrail posts are installed on CDIH piles" was in error.</p> <p>The posts and CIDH piles are not connected. As shown in Sheet 12, the posts and CIDH piles are alternatingly placed. The center-to-center spacing between posts is typically 6'-3". The center-to-center spacing between CIDH piles is also 6'-3" (with an offset of 3'-1 1/2" from the posts).</p> <p>.</p>
