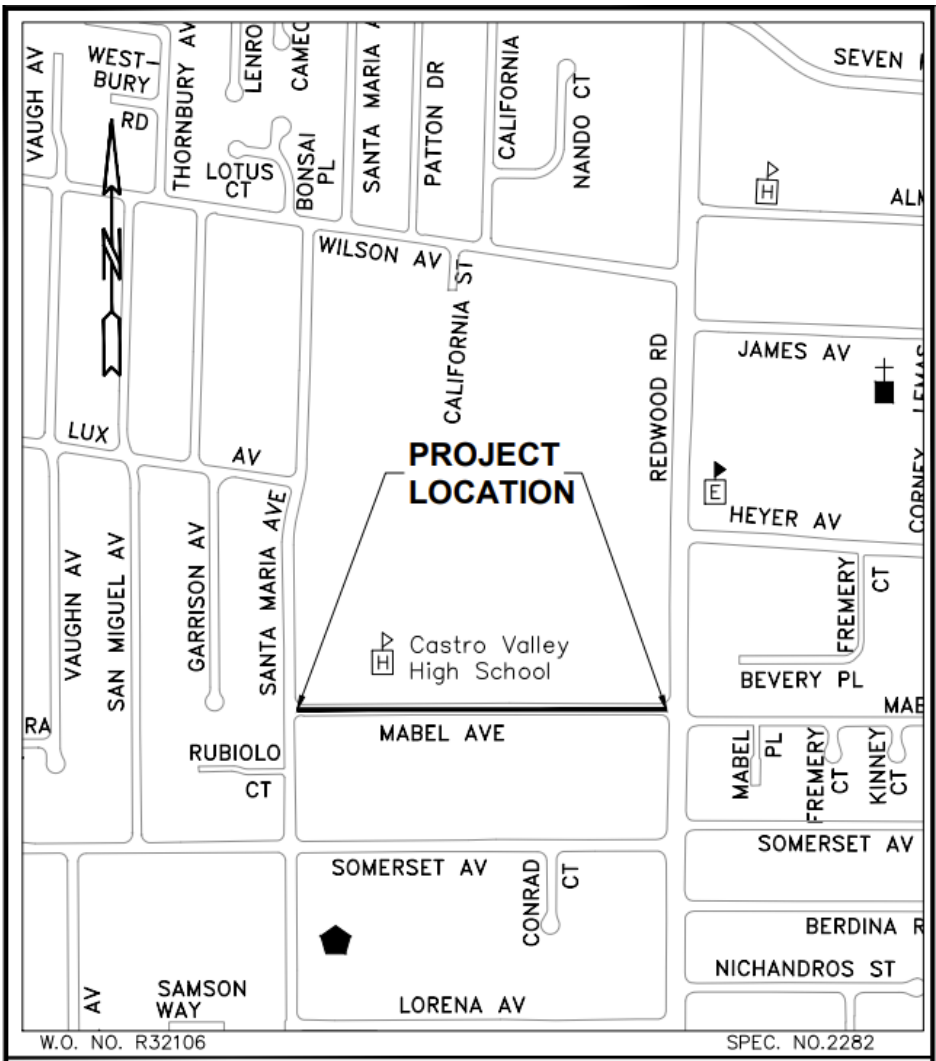
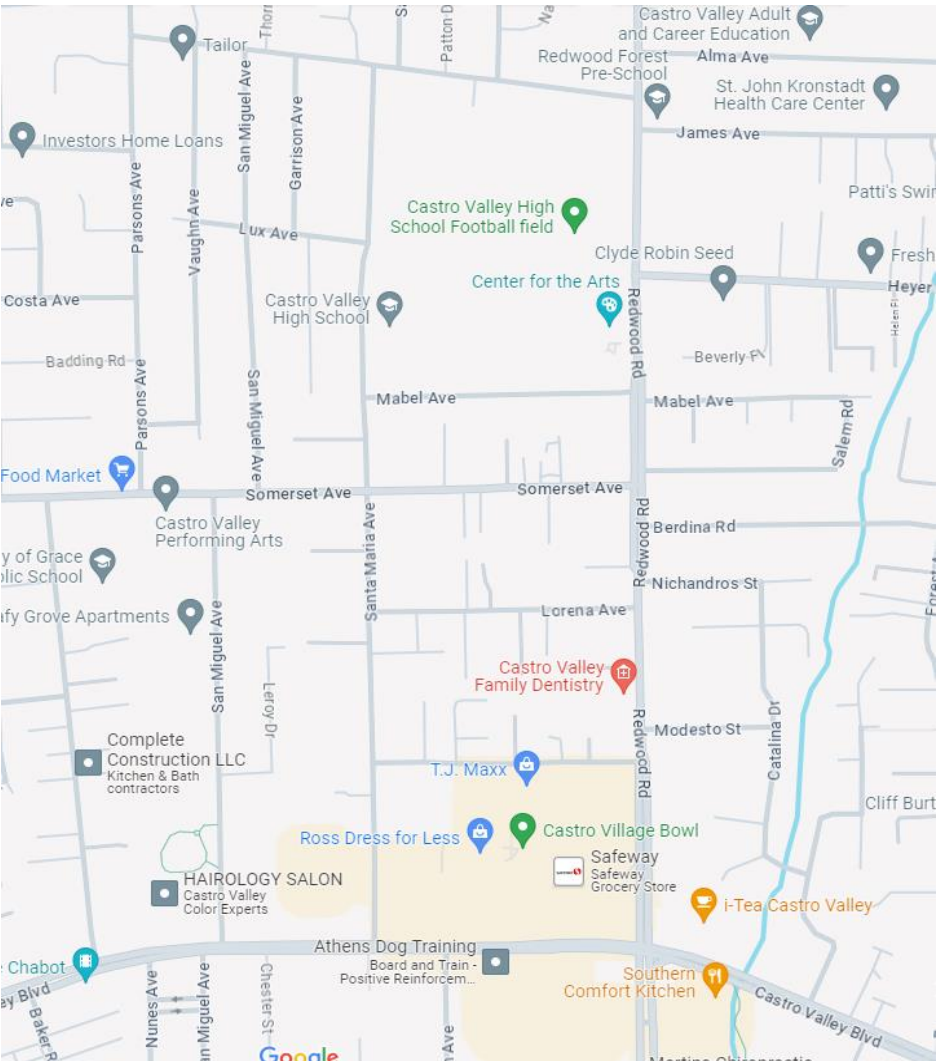

General Project Description

- Removal of Parts of Existing Concrete Curbs and Gutters, and Removal of Existing Dirt/Asphalt Concrete
- Construction of New Concrete Curbs, Gutters, Driveways, Driveway and walkway Conforms, Pervious Concrete Sidewalks, and a Pedestrian Ramp
- Modify Existing Drop Inlet, and Adjust to New Grade Existing Drop Inlet Grate and Cover
- Mill and Overlay
- Adjustment to Finish Grade Existing EBMUD Water Meter and Water Valve Boxes, Traffic Signal Boxes, PG&E Box, Sewer Cleanout Boxes and Cover, Sanitary Sewer Manholes, and Survey Monument

Construction Compliance (Jami)

- **Labor Code Requirements**

- Prevailing wage is applicable to all PWA projects
- Elation Systems is the web-based system that contractors and subcontractors are required to use on a weekly basis for the submission of certified payroll.

- **Contract Compliance**

- Elation Systems is also utilized to monitor subcontractor utilization. Contractors are required to upload all payments made to their subs.
- DIR: All bidders (prime and subcontractors) who bid on a public works project must be registered with the Department of Industrial Relations by the date of bid opening. \$300 ANNUAL FEE.
- Alameda County Public Works Agency strongly encourages the participation of disadvantaged/minority/women-owned business enterprises in all District capital improvement construction projects.

Project Stabilization/Community Benefits Agreement (Jami)

- PS/CBA required for all projects \$1,000,000 and above
- Purpose is to provide, enhance and encourage construction training and employment opportunities for Alameda County residents
- Trucking only on projects \$1,000,000 to \$2,999,999
- All Trades on projects \$3,000,000 and above

- **Contractor Technical Assistance Program (CTAP)** assists small and local contractors
 - Identifies and Shares Alameda County's construction contracting opportunities
 - Provides technical assistance including certification assistance, one-on-one training, workshops, and seminars
 - Offers bonding assistance for qualifying projects up to 40% of the bond amount or \$750,000, whichever is less
 - Works with prime and subcontractors and will work with primes to meet their Small Local Emerging Business (SLEB) or ECOP requirement
- CTAP is sponsored by the General Services Agency (GSA) and administered by Merriwether & Williams Insurance Services
- To be eligible for CTAP contractors must be Alameda County SLEB Certified
