## Responses to Verbal and/or Written Questions

- Q1. What is the approximate budget allocated to projects that will be performed through this procurement?
- A1. The District anticipates that up to approximately \$1 million worth of projects may be assigned, per year, to each of three consultant teams.
- Q2. Within the RFQ, "Appendix F: Small Local Emerging Business (SLEB) Partnering Information Sheet" is watermarked with "For Information Only." Can the District provide a clean version of the form?
- A2. A non-watermarked version of Appendix F is attached herewith.
- Q3. Is there a page limit for the SOQ?
- A3. The District appreciates brevity. While no formal page limit has been specified in the RFQ, consultant teams might consider limiting their response (minus cover, resumes, and forms) to approximately 20 pages.
- Q4. Can the District offer some insight into the types of work to be performed under this contract?
- A4. This procurement covers projects for the District's Watershed Planning section. Please review sections I.B and I.C of the RFQ for an overview of the types of projects to be performed and services needed. Note that the District has already procured a bench of qualified consultants to support the Capital Improvement Program.

## **APPENDIX F**

## SMALL LOCAL EMERGING BUSINESS (SLEB) PARTNERING INFORMATION SHEET

Alameda County Flood Control and Water Conservation District utilizes the Alameda County Small Local Emerging Business (SLEB) program to help grow and build capacity with businesses in Alameda County. In order to meet the SLEB requirements of this RFQ, all firms must complete this form as required below.

Firms not meeting the <u>definition of a SLEB</u> (<a href="http://acgov.org/auditor/sleb/overview.htm">http://acgov.org/auditor/sleb/overview.htm</a>) are required to subcontract with a SLEB for at least twenty percent (20%) of the total estimated proposal amount in order to be considered for contract award. SLEB subcontractors must be independently owned and operated from the prime Contractor with no employees of either entity working for the other. This form must be submitted for each business that firms will work with, as evidence of a firm contractual commitment to meeting the SLEB participation goal. (Copy this form as needed.)

Firms are encouraged to form a partnership with a SLEB that can participate directly with this contract. One of the benefits of the partnership will be economic, but this partnership will also assist the SLEB to grow and build the capacity to eventually propose as a prime on their own.

Once a contract has been awarded, firms will not be able to substitute named subcontractors without prior written approval from the Auditor-Controller, Office of Contract Compliance (OCC).

Alameda County Flood Control and Water Conservation District and the OCC will use the web-based Elation Systems to monitor contract compliance with the SLEB program (Elation Systems: https://www.elationsys.com/APP/).
