- 2 Pump Stations
- 1 Pressure Reducing Station

Sewer System consists of:

- 28,000 LF of Sewer Mains (mainly 6"-8" PVC/HDPE/VCP)
- 125 Manholes



 - Web based system to monitor compliance
 - Certified Payrolls (Prime and Subs).
- DIR Registration
 - Required to be registered to bid on or be part of team
