The following Section(s) has/have been modified or revised as shown below. Changes made to the original RFP/Q document are in **bold** print and highlighted, and deletions made have a strike through.

Page 6 of the RFP/Q, Section I.B (BACKGROUND), Item b(6), is revised as follows:

Pruning of trees in the major and minor irrigated areas to maintain optimum health of the plants and, in the first three (3) years, to correct branching structure; is important throughout the life of the tree to maintain tree health and protect surround structures;

Page 17 of the RFP/Q, Section I.E (SCOPE OF WORK), Item c(2), is revised as follows:

Tree Pruning: During the first three (3) years, prune all trees for correct branching structure. Pruning shall conform to the standards established by the County's Tree Ordinance if applicable.

Page 29 of the RFP/Q, Section I.E (SCOPE OF WORK), Item q(3), is added as follows:

3) Placing new mulching as authorized by a cost proposal approved by the County shall be considered and is billable by the cubic yard installed.

ACPWA Responses to Questions Received

- Q1: Is there a set amount of mulch that we should be purchasing so that the pricing will reflect in the bid?
- **A1**: There is no set amount, we only have a target goal mandated by the State. Mulching is continuous and does not have to be completed in the first year.
- Q2: Is there data specifying the linear feet of V-ditches (page 31)?
- **A2**: V-Ditches are shown in the as-bults drawings included in the RFP. Contractor is responsible for verify the linear feet by using the as-builts or by field verification.

More complex and detailed repairs of the irrigation system, repairs due to accidents or vandalism, etc. will be approved as extra items on a case-by-case basis by the PWA.

*Mulch installation will be charged by contractor to the County on the amount that is installed. A two-inch layer will be maintained at all times and re-

applied on an as needed basis. Quantities listed herein are annual estimates based on past usage and are not to be construed as a commitment.
