PLANNED ROADWAY RESURFACING WORK IN CASTRO VALLEY

Castro Valley, CA — Alameda County Public Works Agency (ACPWA) announces the upcoming start of roadway resurfacing improvements at multiple locations throughout Castro Valley, with construction tentatively scheduled to begin on April 13, 2026. Work is expected to continue through the end of May 2026, though timelines may be adjusted based on weather and field conditions.

The project will deliver pavement improvements along Redwood Road (Castro Valley Boulevard to Charlene Way), and the full length of Columbia Drive, Brecon Court, Independent School Road, Lobert Street, and Tanglewood Drive within Castro Valley. Planned work includes grinding existing pavement surfaces, removing and replacing deteriorated roadway sections, and completing new asphalt paving to enhance roadway quality and extend service life.

Work Schedule -- Due to higher traffic volumes on Redwood Road, work along this corridor will be conducted during **nighttime hours, between 9:00 PM and 5:00 AM**, to minimize impacts to the traveling public. However, work along the other streets will take place during **daytime hours, between 8:30 AM and 4:30 PM**.

Construction Impacts -- During construction, motorists and residents can expect temporary lane closures with traffic control measures in place, as well as intermittent access restrictions and minor delays. Access for residents and emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times. Residents may also experience temporary increases in noise, lighting, and general construction activity, particularly during nighttime operations along Redwood Road.

This project is part of ACPWA's ongoing commitment to maintaining safe, reliable, and well-functioning roadways throughout Alameda County.
