III. TAB MINUTES

August 16, 2017 minutes approved unanimously.

IV. TREE VIOLATION HEARINGS/APPEALS

16138 Via Alamitos San Lorenzo, CA 94580

- Inta presented staff report explaining that a Brazilian Pepper tree had been improperly pruned and that no permits had been issued for the work.
- The recommended fines were: \$100 for work without a permit; \$1000 administrative penalty; and \$367.12 for the cost of the appraisal report.
- The recommended abatement was: \$1040 paid into a mitigation fund for loss of value; and tree needs to be removed and replaced.
- Mr. Herman Lee, property owner, explained that he was not aware that
 permits were required. He further explained that he was concerned about the
 tree growing into his and his neighbor's service drops and causing a fire.
 Because he planted the tree in his front yard, he did not think he needed
 permission to prune the tree.
- TAB members explained right of way (ROW), how the tree was improperly pruned, and the need to contact PG&E regarding the wires.
- TAB member, Don Nelson, made a motion to require Mr. Lee to plant a 15 gallon tree in the ROW; pay the \$100 fine for work without a permit and the

- appraisal cost of \$367.12; and that the administrative penalty and abatement costs be waived. No second, motion failed.
- TAB member, Dee Mcdonough, motioned that Mr. Lee pay the \$100 fine for work without a permit; the cost of the appraisal for \$367.12; half the administrative penalty, \$500; and for the abatement, the tree be removed, stump ground, and replaced with another tree in the larger portion of the yard. The motion was moved, seconded, and unanimously approved.
- The motion was explained to Mr. Lee that he would be responsible for paying a total \$967.12 for penalties and appraisal cost and for the removal of the tree and stump, and the planting of a replacement tree. Mr. Lee indicated he understood and was dismissed.

Staff Report on Violation of Tree Ordinance Incident

Violation: It was reported and documented that (1) Sycamore tree was improperly pruned

and no permits were acquired for the work. Property Owner of Record: Dayani Aguilar

Address Where Violation Occurred: 21324 Times Ave., Hayward, CA 94541

Background for appeal of fine:

On April 12, 2017 staff was notified by the Sidewalk Program that a tree located at the above address had been improperly pruned. Staff were provided pictures and a copy of a Sidewalk Repair Program Arborist Review Request. On April 13, 2017, staff contacted Hortscience (Consultant) to request a Tree Evaluation and Appraisal of Value. Consultant inspected the tree on April 24, 2017 and provided their assessment on May 5, 2017. Staff mailed a Notice of Violation (NOV) on June 13, 2017 and provided a revised invoice on August 11, 2017. Mr. Aguilar responded after receiving a second request for invoice payment in November. He indicated that he had not received any prior notices nor had he received any invoices. On December 12, 2017 staff sent another NOV by certified mail that was returned. Staff called Mr. Aguilar on January 19, 2018 to advise about returned notice. Mrs. Aguilar came to the office on January 19, 2018 to pick up her NOV packet. On January 30, 2018, she hand delivered a letter of appeal along with the appeals fee. The matter was scheduled for the next TAB meeting (February 21, 2018) and on February 6, 2018 the property owner was sent a Notice of Hearing.

The following fines were assessed in accordance with Sections 12.11.220 Fees and 12.11.250 Administrative penalties:

- \$100.00 for work without a permit
- \$1000.00 administrative penalty
- \$206.35 cost of tree appraisal

Background for hearing on abatement:

Same as above for appeal.

The following required corrective actions are to be taken in order to comply with Section 12.11.130 Abatement Authority:

- Acquire permit for removal and replacement of the damaged tree;
- Remove damaged tree and grind stump;
- Replace with a 24" boxed approved tree;
- Pay \$1800.00 into a mitigation fund for the loss of value of the tree(s).

Recently we received a public sidewalk request from the subject property owner. I performed a sidewalk inspection yesterday and took the attached photos.

- I will be submitting the regular consulting arborist review request but I thought you should see these photos. Someone did some serious pruning on the tree. The cut ends of the various branches/limbs show that such was done quite recently.
- Perhaps the pruning was done with permit or by PG&E or by a tree contractor registered with your dept. The pruning looks significant and I thought such should be brought to Urban Forestry's attention. I have also included Google Map photos taken August 2016 to show the tree pre-pruning condition.

Please advise of any tree issues that may affect this SRP application or that may affect the regular consulting arborist review request.

Comments:	 The expected repair will include 24 lin. ft. of s/w plus c/g. While the s/w lifting is more pronounced at the southern end of the property, there may be a considerable amount of root work involved due to the expected overall length of s/w repair. The existing tree appears to have been severely pruned. The report should include an evaluation & professional opinion on the effect of this recent tree pruning on the expected health tree decline and structural integrity over the next 5 to 10 years and whether this pruning will be the major cause of any such decline/deficiency. 			

The arborist's report should address the following in addition to any regular review comments:

- 1. Expected tree root mass: i.e. Negligible, Low, Moderate, Significant, High (N, L, M, S, H).
- 2. Expected future infrastructure damage: 5 10 year timeframe (N, L, M, S, H).
- 3. Expected tree health decline: 5 10 year timeframe (N, L, M, S, H).
- 4. Expected tree effect on public/property safety: 5 10 year timeframe (N, L, M, S, H).
- 5. Expected 'Tree Removal Recommendation' during s/w repair (N, L, M, S, H).
- 6. Suggested sidewalk modification (Suggested/Necessary; Configuration; Dimension; etc.).
- 7. Root barrier requirement (Yes/No, Type/Manufacturer/Length/Depth, etc.).
- 8. Arborist in-field inspections during construction (Yes/No).

Notice of Violation, Imposition of Penalty, and Required Abatement

Re: Tree Work

Dear Property Owner:

A tree has been improperly pruned in the County Road Right-of-Way adjacent to your property at the above address. The improper pruning was unpermitted and illegal. The County of Alameda's Tree Ordinance ("Ordinance") provides as follows:

- Section 12.11.140: "The planting, maintaining, or removing of any tree in the right-of-way, and all associated facilities... are encroachments subject to the permitting and other requirements of this Chapter."
- Section 12.11.110: "In accordance with the California Government Code, Section 53067, no person shall top, head back, stub or pollard any tree located within the right-of-way."
- Section 12.11.130: "The Director will require replacement of a tree within the right-of-way that is improperly removed or damaged. Where replacement is inadequate to correct the harm caused by an improperly removed or damaged tree or is impracticable, the Director may also require the property owner to pay the loss of value of such tree into a tree mitigation fund as abatement for such loss of value."
- Section 12.11.250: "Any person, including, but not limited to, the property owner, the person performing the work, and/or any other responsible person, who violates the provisions of this Chapter or any condition imposed upon any permit issued hereunder shall be liable to the County for a civil penalty of up to \$1000 per violation, under a schedule of penalties established by the Director and approved by the Board."

Per the enclosed arborist's report, the tree that was improperly pruned is considered a total loss and cannot be salvaged. Pre-pruning, the value of the tree was \$1800, for a total of \$1800 in loss of value (see attached appraisal). The destruction of this high-value tree cannot be adequately corrected by planting a sapling.

Pursuant to the Ordinance, you are ordered to do the following:

Pay Fines
\$100.00 fine for work without a permit
\$206.35 for cost of appraisal report
\$1000.00 for civil penalties

Abate Damage

Acquire permit for removal and replacement of the damaged tree Remove damaged tree and grind stump Replace with a 24 inch boxed tree (see enclosed guidelines) Pay \$1800 into mitigation fund for the loss of value of the tree

In order to avoid collection efforts, special assessment of the amounts owing, application of interest for late payment, or additional penalties for noncompliance, please make payment of the total monetary amount (\$3106.35) within 30 days. Cash or a check may be brought or mailed to the County's Fiscal Department at 399 Elmhurst St. Hayward. Your check should be made payable to "Alameda County Treasurer's Office." Please be sure to denote the invoice number (17T06:05) with your payment. Please see section 12.11.280 of the Ordinance for discussion of the consequences of noncompliance.

Enclosed is a permit application to remove the remainder of the tree. You must submit the application within 30 days to the County's Permit Center at 399 Elmhurst St., Hayward.

Should you wish to appeal the \$100.00 fine, the civil penalties totaling \$1000.00, or the cost of the appraisal, you may submit a letter of appeal to the Tree Advisory Board no later than 30 days after the date of this notice. The letter of appeal may be submitted to the Public Works Agency Director's attention: Daniel Woldesenbet, 399 Elmhurst St., Hayward, CA 94544. An appeal must include an address to send all notices, the \$25 appeals fee, and all supporting documentation. Please see section 12.11.260 of the Ordinance for more information.

As to the required abatement, you may request a hearing before the Tree Advisory Board. If a hearing is requested, the Tree Advisory Board shall hear the matter and make a written recommendation to the Board of Supervisors following the hearing. Requests for hearing must be submitted in writing to the Director of Public Works within ten days. If no request for hearing is received, this abatement order shall be final. Please see section 12.11.130 of the Ordinance for more information.

Dear Ms. Brainerd:

The Alameda County Public Works Agency is responsible for administering tree pruning and removal permits for trees within County rights-of way, in accordance with the Alameda County Tree Ordinance (Sec. 12.11.230 of the Alameda County General Code). To help determine losses associated with Improper pruning or un-permitted removals, the County requested that HortScience, Inc. evaluate the current condition of the tree, provide management recommendations as appropriate, and establish any loss in value.

I visited the subject site on April 24, 2017. This letter summarizes my observations and assessment.

Background

You contacted me on March 10, 2017 after noticing the pruning of a London plane tree (*Platanus x hispanica*) at the subject site.

Since I had no photographs showing the tree pre-pruning, I used the Google Earth street view.© of the subject site to assist me in establishing tree condition.

From my review of the historic images available from Google Earth street view ©, the tree has a history of topping for the overhead utility lines and has never had a full canopy. I used the August 2016 image as the basis for the pre-pruning condition.

Observations and Assessment

The London plane was located in the front yard of the Times Ave. address, approximately 3' behind the sidewalk. The tree had a single trunk, measuring 24" in diameter at 54" above grade and had displaced the adjacent sidewalk and curb and gutter by 2-3". Prepruning, the tree had a partial canopy due to the topping for the overhead utilities. I considered the pre-pruning condition to be fair (rated as 50%).

The tree had been topped at ~15', removing ~100% of the live foliage (Photo, following page). The pruning consisted of cutting ~20 branches to 3-7" diameter stubs. Pruning was not performed according to the Best Management Practices for Pruning (International Society of Arboriculture, 2002) and to the most recent editions of the American National Standard for Tree Care Operations (Z133.1) and Pruning (A300). The tree was in poor condition due to the pruning (rated as 30%). The London plane can recover from the topping, but I see no reason to recommend restorative pruning if it will continue to be topped periodically by the utility company.

Appraisal of Loss

To establish the loss in value associated with damage resulting from pruning, I employed the standard methods found in *Guide for Plant Appraisal*, 9th edition (published in 2000 by the International Society of Arboriculture, Savoy IL). In addition, I referred to *Species Classification and Group Assignment* (2004), a publication of the Western Chapter of the International Society of Arboriculture. These two documents outline the methods employed in tree appraisal.

The value of landscape trees is based upon four factors: size, species, condition and location. Size is measured as trunk diameter, normally 54" above grade. The species factor considers the adaptability and appropriateness of the plant in the East Bay. The Species Classification and **Group Assignment lists** recommended species ratings and evaluations. Condition reflects the health and structural integrity of the tree. In this case, I used the aerial photo provided and the Google Earth street view @ to help establish the prepruning condition. The location factor considers the site, placement and contribution of a tree in its surrounding landscape. In this case, the tree is located in a residential area in San Lorenzo.

Any loss associated with the pruning, would be the difference in value before and after it was pruned. Based on my assessment of the value of the tree before and after the pruning, I established the loss in value to be \$1,800 (see attached appraisal worksheets).

Staff inspected the location on December 14, 2017 and found that a Sycamore tree had been removed and the stump remained. Staff sent a request for a loss of value report to Hortscience (Consultant) on December 15, 2017. Consultant inspected the location on January 2, 2018 and provided the report on January 15, 2018. On January 30, 2018, staff mailed a Notice of Violation (NOV) and invoice. Staff had several phone conversations with Alen Chan who called on behalf of the owners. 

Dear Property Owners:

A tree has been removed from the County Road Right-of-Way adjacent to your property at the above address. The removal was unpermitted and illegal. The County of Alameda's Tree Ordinance ("Ordinance") provides as follows:

- Section 12.11.140: "The planting, maintaining, or removing of any tree in the right-of-way, and all associated facilities... are encroachments subject to the permitting and other requirements of this Chapter."
- Section 12.11.110: "In accordance with the California Government Code, Section 53067, no person shall top, head back, stub or pollard any tree located within the right-of-way."
- Section 12.11.130: "The Director will require replacement of a tree within the right-of-way that is improperly removed or damaged. Where replacement is inadequate to correct the harm caused by an improperly removed or damaged tree or is impracticable, the Director may also require the property owner to pay the loss of value of such tree into a tree mitigation fund as abatement for such loss of value."
- Section 12.11.250: "Any person, including, but not limited to, the property owner, the person performing the work, and/or any other responsible person, who violates the provisions of this Chapter or any condition imposed upon any permit issued hereunder shall be liable to the County for a civil penalty of up to \$1000 per violation, under a schedule of penalties established by the Director and approved by the Board."

Pursuant to the Ordinance, you are ordered to do the following:

Pay Fines \$100.00 fine for work without a permit \$681.08.00 for cost of appraisal report \$1000.00 for civil penalties

The enclosed arborist report shows the basis for the fine.

The condition of the tree also requires abatement to correct the violation.

Per the enclosed arborist's report, the tree that was removed is considered a total loss. Pre-removal, the value of the tree was \$4600, for a total of \$4600 in loss of value (see attached appraisal). The destruction of this high-value tree cannot be adequately corrected by planting a sapling.

The recommended method(s) of abatement are:

Abate Damage

Pay \$4600 into mitigation fund for the loss of value of the tree; Remove tree and grind stump; Plant replacement tree.

In order to avoid collection efforts, special assessment of the amounts owing, application of interest for late payment, or additional penalties for noncompliance, please make payment of the fine amount (\$1781.08) within 30 days. Cash or a check may be brought or mailed to the County's Fiscal Department at 399 Elmhurst St. Hayward. Your check should be made payable to "Alameda County Treasurer's Office." Please be sure to denote the invoice number (18T01:02) with your payment. Please see section 12.11.280 of the Ordinance for discussion of the consequences of noncompliance.

Enclosed is a permit application to remove the remainder of the trees.

Should you wish to appeal the fine or the cost of the appraisal, you may submit a letter of appeal to the Tree Advisory Board no later than 30 days after the date of this notice. The letter of appeal may be submitted to the Public Works Agency Director's attention: Daniel Woldesenbet, 399 Elmhurst St., Hayward, CA 94544. An appeal must include an address to send all notices, the \$25 appeals fee, and all supporting documentation. Please see section 12.11.260 of the Ordinance for more information.

As to the required abatement, you may request a hearing before the Tree Advisory Board. If a hearing is requested, the Tree Advisory Board shall hear the matter and make a written recommendation to the Board of Supervisors following the hearing. Requests for hearing must be submitted in writing to the Director of Public Works within ten days of this notice. If no request for hearing is received, the abatement order shall be presented to the Board of Supervisors for adoption. Please see section 12.11.130 of the Ordinance for more information.

Dear Ms. Brainerd:

The Alameda County Public Works Agency is responsible for administering tree pruning and removal permits for trees within County rights-of way, in accordance with the Alameda County Tree Ordinance (Sec. 12.11.230 of the Alameda County General Code). To help determine losses associated with improper pruning or un-permitted removals, the County requested that HortScience, Inc. evaluate the current condition of the tree, provide management recommendations as appropriate, and establish any loss in value.

I visited the subject site on January 2, 2018. This letter summarizes my observations and assessment.

Background

You contacted me on December 15, 2017 after noticing the removal of a London plane (*Platanus x hispanica*) at the subject site without a County permit.

Since I had no photographs showing the tree pre-removal, I used the Google Earth street view © of the subject site to assist me in establishing the pre-removal tree condition.

From my review of the historic images available from Google Earth street view ©, the tree had a small canopy and fair branch structure (Photos 1 and 2, following page). It appeared that the tree had been topped at some point in the past. I estimated that pre-removal, the tree was in fair condition (60%).

Observations and Assessment

The London plane was located in the front yard of the Via Carmen address, approximately 2' behind the sidewalk. The tree had been removed at the time of my inspection and only the stump remained. I measured the stump at approximately 32" in diameter (Photo 3, following page).

In addition, while at the site I measured the diameters (basal and at breast height) of three similarly sized London planes in the vicinity of the removed tree. I used this information to help establish the diameter of the removed tree by comparing the basal diameters with the diameters at breast height.

Based on this information, I estimated the trunk diameter of the removed tree at 24".

The *Guide for Plant Appraisal* outlines three methods for establishing the value of plants: the Cost approach, the Income approach and the Market approach. I chose to use the cost approach as it is most applicable for large trees that cannot be replaced inkind.

The value of landscape trees is based upon four factors: size, species, condition and location. Size is measured as trunk diameter, normally 54" above grade. The species factor considers the adaptability and appropriateness of the plant in the East Bay. The Species Classification and Group Assignment lists recommended species ratings and evaluations. Condition reflects the health and structural integrity of the tree. In this case, I used Google Earth street view © to help establish the pre-removal condition. The location factor considers the site, placement and contribution of a tree in its surrounding landscape. In this case, the tree is located in a residential area in San Lorenzo.

I established the cost to reproduce the subject tree as \$4,600. Thus, the loss in value was \$4,600 (see attached Appraisal Worksheet).
