## CROW CANYON PROJECT RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS

UNINCORPORATED ALAMEDA COUNTY – Paving work on Crow Canyon Road between Castro Valley Boulevard and Coldwater Drive is currently scheduled to resume on May 2<sup>nd</sup>, pending weather conditions. To date, the first layer of asphalt and temporary striping have been placed on the road. The final paving will include two additional paving layers followed by final striping.

The work is anticipated to take approximately three-weeks to complete. Work will take place between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. On some days, work may not start until 10:00 a.m. to allow for warmer temperatures.

The work will be done in three phases as outlined below:

Phase 1: Paving work will be between Castro Valley Boulevard and Greenridge Road. This phase is expected to take place between May 2 and May 10.

Phase 2: Paving work will be between Greenridge Road and Coldwater Drive. During this phase, residents seeking access to the Greenridge neighborhood from the south may wish to enter the neighborhood from Cull Canyon Road. This phase is expected to take place between May 11 and May 16.

Phase 3: Striping – This is the final phase of the project whereby final striping will be installed from Castro Valley Boulevard to Coldwater Drive. This phase is expected to take three-days during the week of May 16<sup>th</sup>.

Please note that the schedule may change due to inclement weather, equipment breakdowns, and other unforeseen circumstances.

TRAVEL IMPACTS: Work will impact afternoon school pickups and evening commutes. Expect up to 30-minute delays, reduced speeds, traffic flaggers, and single-lane traffic in the work zone. Plan extra travel time and slow down.
