

# NILES CANYON TRAIL



Niles District in Fremont to Sunol in Alameda County

## PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Alameda County Public Works Agency (ACPWA) and its project partners, including the Cities of Fremont and Union City, as well as the East Bay Regional Park District, San Francisco Public Utilities Commission, and the Alameda County Water District, are planning a **new trail that links the Niles District in Fremont and the unincorporated community of Sunol.**



## PROJECT FEATURES

This new trail will serve walkers, bikers, and equestrians commencing at the end of the Alameda Creek trail in Niles along 6-miles to the Sunol train station. The trail will traverse the rugged terrain paralleling Alameda Creek and the Niles Canyon railway. It will be 10 feet wide, paved in asphalt, and designed to be accessible to all users and abilities.

The trail will include a bridge linking it to Palomares Road creating a safe crossing of State Route 84. To accommodate user parking, the project features staging areas in downtown Niles, Palomares Road, and a new parking area to be constructed by the East Bay Regional Park District in Sunol.
