TRAFFIC PATTERN CHANGE ON STROBRIDGE AVENUE AND NORBRIDGE AVENUE IN THE VICINITY OF THE INTERSTATE 580 OFF-RAMP

CASTRO VALLEY, ALAMEDA COUNTY – Beginning **Wednesday, June 25, 2025**, a new traffic pattern will go into effect on **Strobridge Avenue** and **Norbridge Avenue** between the **Interstate 580 off-ramp** and Castro Valley Blvd in Castro Valley. These changes are part of the substantially completed **Strobridge/Norbridge Intersection Improvement Project**, designed to enhance safety, traffic flow, and local access.

Key Traffic Changes Taking Effect June 25:

- **Strobridge Avenue:** The current **one-way** configuration from Castro Valley Boulevard to the I-580 westbound off-ramp will be converted to **two-way travel**.
- **Norbridge Avenue:** The current **one-way** stretch from approximately 550 feet west of Tye Court to Castro Valley Boulevard will also change to **two-way travel**.

Motorists are urged to exercise caution, follow all posted signage and pavement markings, and stay alert as they become familiar with the new roadway configurations.
